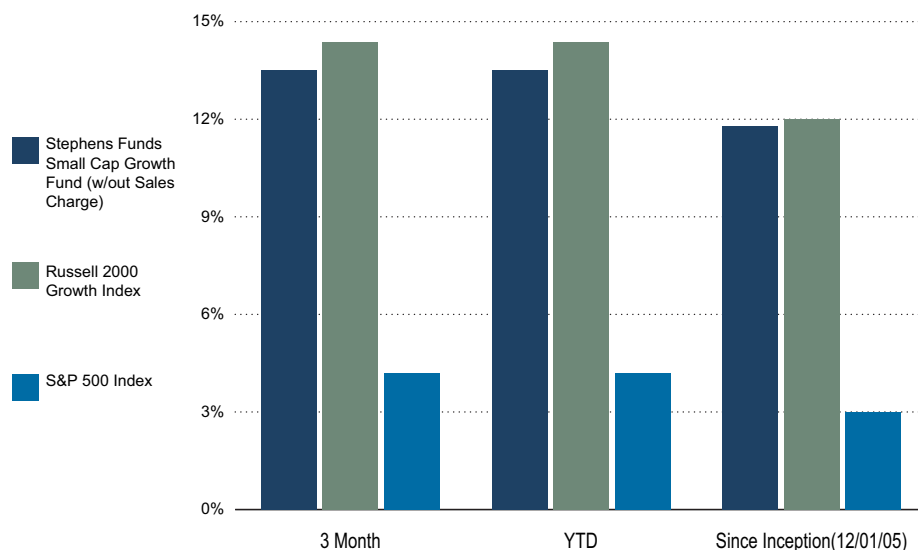
As part of our fundamental analysis, we conduct in-depth industry reviews, company management meetings, and perform a comprehensive examination of each company's business model and growth opportunities.

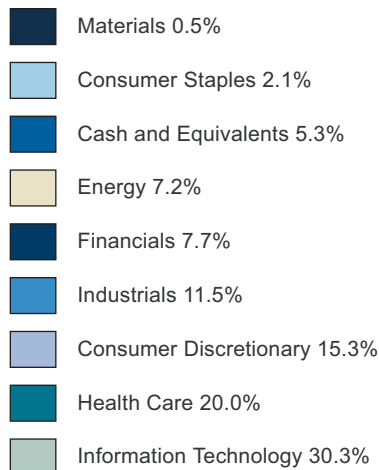
